Dear Parents

As we enter the next stage of 'living with Covid', I wanted to update you with what this means for schools.

- Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.
- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious.
- For children and young people aged 18 and under with a positive Covid test, the advice is to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days.
- Pupils who are absent due to a positive Covid test, will be provided with remote teaching. In all other illness cases, remote learning will not be provided, as if the children are well enough to learn they should be in school.
- Children DO NOT need to do negative tests to return to school after Covid. They can come back on day 4 if they are well enough.
