Welcome back to school

Welcome back to the start of a new year at St. George & St. Martin Catholic Ocademy! We are so looking forward to teaching your children in their last year at our school. We have a busy year ahead and the children have made an enthusiastic start especially in their new role as leaders of our school

We will be teaching a variety of different subjects in Year 6 and the children will enjoy a full and rich curriculum. The children will love reading this, and it will help develop both the children's reading and writing skills

The children will be taught a variety of different subjects which will cover all areas of the National Curriculum. Here is a taster of just some of the things we may learn:

- Immediate recall of times tables and associated division facts
- Mental addition and subtraction, multiplication and division
- Place value and rounding
- Written methods for addition and subtraction, multiplication and division
- Fractions

- Spellings given out at the start of each half term, to be tested in school at the end of each half term.

- Maths homework will be an arithmetic or reasoning task
- Maths homework to be returned the following Friday.
- Children have daily maths homework, consisting of 4 calculation questions.
- Children expected to practise times tables at home using 'Times Tables Rock Stars', ready for a times tables test in class each week

PE

- Children have PE on Fridays.
- PE (PE kit should be in school <u>every day</u> in case of a change to the timetable)

EVERY DAY!

 Children should bring their folders with reading books, diaries and their water bottle.

What can you do at home?

- Children who struggle with reading should ideally read to an adult at home as often as possible. Please sign reading diaries when this has taken place.
- All children should be reading independently (or to an adult) for at least 20 minutes per day. Children should record all their reading in their diaries.
- Encourage children to practice all their times tables and related division facts and to recall them quickly.
- Encourage children to complete homework promptly and practice spellings regularly.
- Encourage children to be aware of home and world events by reading newspapers and watching programmes such as Newsround on CBBC channel http:// www.bbccouk/newsround/38949047
