

Behaviour

- 1) Always follow SGSM rules.
- 2) During setting up the hall children in EYFS are to remain sat by the lift with toys in the stadium where KS1 and KS2 children can help with chairs, mats and toys
- 3) Children are encouraged at snack time to tidy up their table space to help build the skill of table manners.
- 4) Excellent behaviour will be rewarded with Dojo points, green cards or certificates.
