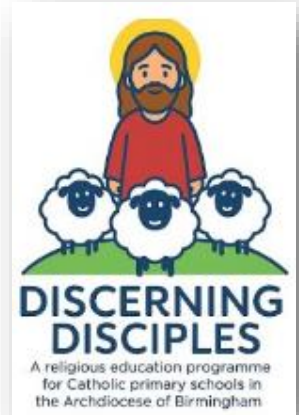
Corpus Christi
